APRICOT 2013

- Singapore, 19th February 1st March
- 760 participants from 48 countries
- Hosted by SGNIC
- 5 days of workshop, 5 days of tutorial & conference
- Workshops included:
 - 2x IPv4/v6 BGP Routing, Network Management, ISP Security and MPLS
- Conference included:
 - APOPS, APNIC Policy & Member Meeting, iGov, AP* organisations, Technical Breakouts, etc





- APRICOT 2014
 - Bangkok, 18th 28th February
- APRICOT 2015
 - Fukuoka, 24th February 6th March
 - Will be held jointly with APAN 39
- Forward planning is vital
 - Conference awarded 2 years prior to first day
 - Serious work starts 9 months prior to the event
 - Future host MUST participate on organisation committee and organisation activities of the prior event





- Two meetings per year in the Middle East
- MENOG 12
 - 5th 14th March 2013 in Dubai
 - Two 5 day workshops
 - IPv6 & Network Management Tools
 - 185 attendees from 38 countries
 - Held along with Middle East Peering Forum
- MENOG 13
 - 15th 24th September 2013 in Kuwait
 - Two 5 day workshops offered
 - One day tutorial and two day conference





- Two meetings per year in the Pacific Islands
- PacNOG 12
 - 10th 14th December 2012 in Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea
 - 1 day conference, 4 days workshops
 - Workshops included:
 - BGP Routing/IXP and Internet & Network Security
- PacNOG 13
 - 1st 5th July 2013 in Nuku'alofa, Tonga
 - 1 day conference, 4 days of workshops
 - Workshops include:
 - Linux System Administration and Introduction to Routing





- SANOG 21,
 - 27th January 4th February 2013, Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh
- SANOG 22
 - 5th 13th August 2013, Mumbai, India
- Standard established formula:
 - Three 5 day workshops,
 - 2 days of tutorials
 - 1.5 days of conference plenary
- One SANOG per year now held in India
 - Agreement with ISPAI





- NZNOG 2013
 - 21st 25th January 2013, Wellington
 - 3 day workshops, 1 day tutorial, 2 day conference
 - At least 120 participants from New Zealand and the surrounding region
- NZNOG 2014
 - Last week of January, in Nelson
- Informal organisation
 - Most NZNOG activity based around mailing list
 - InternetNZ provides supporting entity
